You have indicated an interest in becoming a volunteer for the TRNWR Wildlife Center. Volunteers are currently needed in two areas. All necessary training will be provided and both experienced volunteers and enthusiastic novices are encouraged to apply!

The information desk and store area, Nature's Overlook, is an important position that includes providing visitor information, retail, and handling cash. There are also Wildlife Center 'rovers' who greet and talk to visitors on busy days in the lobby, indoor and outdoor viewing areas, and interpretive areas. We accept and process applications for these positions on an ongoing basis.

Details regarding eligibility and training:

- Wildlife Center volunteers working behind the information desk and Nature's Overlook must be current Friends of the Refuge Group Members. If you are not a member or need to renew your membership, you may do so any time prior to starting. Visit their website at www.friendsoftualatinrefuge.org for more information.
- Training for all positions are scheduled on an as-needed basis; every few months at least. They are usually on a weekend day or weekday evening, and last 3-4 hours. One-on-one training for Nature's Overlook sales system is scheduled after group training.
- Wildlife Center volunteers must be willing to commit to a minimum of 8 hours per month. Shifts will be 3.5-4 hours in length. AM, PM, and weekend shifts are available.
